Carl Malamud - Director of the Digital Resources Institute at the University of Colorado and head of the "Bruno Project" which converted and made available the CCI standards on internetworked servers - is visiting the ITU again. He has offered to give a brief seminar focussing both on the very initial statistics of the Project, as well as current Internet/networking developments.

As those who attended Mr. Malamud's first seminar know, it was highly informative and interesting. The Bruno Project was unbelievably successful. In just 4 weeks, there are now 21 servers all over the world making the standards available, and current file accesses are estimated on the order of one-half million. ISO, IEEE and other organizations are now considering availability in a similar fashion. If you are an information systems user, you will not want to miss this seminar.
