### Introduction

The text data contained on this two CD-ROM set represent a release of the JI (Justice Department Retrieval and Inquiry System) data collection that has been available to the Linguistic Data Consortium (LDC) by the U.S. Department o The time span of the text ranges from the 1700s to the early 1990s.

#### Data

There are 1,664 individual text files in the corpus, 1011 on the first CD-RON on the second. The original archive consisted of 219 files ranging between lea MB and nearly 70 MB in size. In order to make the data more accessible for a use, we chose to divide the larger files into pieces, such that the average file s about 2 MB when uncompressed (the largest uncompressed file size is about MB).
